Shrigley Hall is a former country house standing to the northwest of the village of Pott Shrigley. It has since been used as a school, when a chapel was added, and later as a hotel and country club operated by The Hotel Collection.

The hall was built in about 1825 for William Turner, a Blackburn mill owner and Member of Parliament. During the 20th century the building was used as a school by the religious institute of the Salesians of Don Bosco, who in 1936 added a chapel to the south of the house, dedicating it to Saint John Bosco. An attic was added to the house in the middle of the 20th century and in 1989 the house and church were converted into a hotel, spa and country club.

The Tilden Suite

The suite is located in the original church that was built in 1926 by the monks for their own worship. The Tilden Suite has a beautiful dome roof, dramatic stone mantels and stained-glass windows. A venue with a difference offering over 470 square meters of space, the suite has its own bar, reception area and dance floor. The room is totally versatile for all types of banquets, conferences and weddings and will be an ideal venue to host our Gala Dinner on Saturday 9th October 2021.
