

### What it entails

Following the completion of the course those who have attended will receive a 'Certificate of Attendance' awarded by the BIFD, which can be considered as CPD by their employers.

### What it will cost

There is a fee payable to the BIFD for the training day for the Presenters and the material which you will be given in order to take the sessions; each attendee will pay you a fee, which is whatever you want it to be to cover the BIFD fees and your side of the cost for expenses and charges.
